

Millbrook Housing Committee
Housing Rules
(Revised November 2016)

1. No applicant may attend housing committee meetings to address the members.
2. Once an applicant accepts a new house, the decision is considered permanent and renders that applicant ineligible for any other housing. This does not apply to housing that was designated as being temporary.
3. The housing committee chairperson will post results of all committee decisions on a public bulletin board and website, once ratified by Chief and Council.
4. All applications for housing must have all legal documents attached. (ie. Marriage, Legal Common law, custody orders, etc.)
5. All applications for housing must have Release Forms attached.
6. Applicants that have previously been evicted from Millbrook housing/apartments have a 3-year waiting period before being considered eligible to applying for Millbrook housing/apartments again.
7. Applicants that list a spouse under the age of eighteen (18) years old will have to be registered common law to be considered eligible on their housing application.
9. Married couples must be living together under the same roof.
