#### Nova Scotia Power Smart Meters Coming Soon To Your Community

Nova Scotia Power will be introducing new Smart Meters technology that will be installed to homes in Nova Scotia, which will include all 13 Mi'kmaw Communities. In June of 2018, Nova Scotia Power Inc. (NSPI) received approval from the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board to upgrade all electrical meters on homes and businesses to Smart Meters, which will help in modernizing Nova Scotia's electrical system.

There will be as many as 500,000 upgrades throughout Nova Scotia. We hope that our Mi'kmaq people will have the opportunity to work during this installation and be a part of these new changes.

The installations will begin this Fall and will continue into 2021, until all upgrades are completed. Once the Smart Meters are installed, they will activate the new and improved smart technology.

NSPI has contracted *Tribus Services* to do the meter upgrades. *Tribus* has over 20 years of experience and has completed more than 25 million Smart Meter upgrades. *Tribus* will perform the upgrade in accordance with NSPI's safety requirements and customer service standards.

#### **Benefits of Smart Meters**

- Access to daily information on your energy consumption, enabling you to make more informed decisions on how you use electricity. You'll also have the option to set billing notifications to help manage your electricity costs.
- Smart Meters will notify NSPI when your power goes out. They will be able to troubleshoot remotely, and, if needed, send a crew to help get the power back on. This will enable a quicker response in the event of an outage.
- Smart Meters will enable remote connection or disconnection of electricity without an on-site appointment, making it quicker and easier for you.
- Job opportunities within Mi'kmaw communities: *Tribus* have been hosting career fairs across the province. They are hiring for a variety of positions including Electric Meter Installers.






