

Home Insurance



Millbrook First Nation's insurance covers the structural costs of CMHC houses and Millbrook-owned homes on reserve. Please note that the contents inside the homes, including the appliances, are not insured by the First Nation. It is important to protect your belongings and one way to do that is to consider purchasing home insurance for the contents of your home. This became apparent after the recent flooding of basements that occurred in Millbrook's communities last year. If Millbrook members are interested in home contents insurance, they will be responsible and it will not be covered by the First Nation. Questions? Housing Inspections

The Housing Department has been working collaboratively with other organizations and government agencies with the hopes of obtaining funding for housing repairs. In order to be eligible for the housing repairs, housing inspections will be mandatory for the funding.

Those who contact the Housing Department to be added to the list will be first priority, but it's mandatory for all houses to be inspected. Anyone who doesn't answer the door for their scheduled appointment will be dropped down to the end of the list.

INFORMATION SESSION CUSTOM ELECTION CODE

Dear Millbrook First Nation Members,

Please join us to learn about the new process before it is taken to the community for ratification.

From April 25th to May 31st, we will be hosting a series of engagement sessions regarding the Custom Election Code that was drafted by the Millbrook Election Committee. The committee is comprised of registered Millbrook First Nation members from a variety of backgrounds, diverse ages and experiences. All who applied were accepted. The draft Code is the culmination of their work and months of discussions.

The goal of developing our own election code was to develop a leadership selection process that addressed the challenges posed by the Indian Act process - by exercising our right to self-governance. It should be noted that the purpose of developing a new code is to improve upon the process by which leaders are chosen, NOT to redefine the governance roles of our Chief and Council.

Over the next few weeks we will be sharing the draft with the community for review and input. Additionally, we will be putting pieces of the Code in the community bulletin and newsletter. Ultimately, the community will vote on whether or not to accept the code (tentatively booked for the end of this summer), which is why we are starting the engagement process early – so folks can make informed decisions at the polls.



Mi'kmaw Chiefs, Federal and Provincial Governments Sign MOU To Advance Mi'kmaq Health Care



On April 21 at Millbrook's Cultural and Heritage Centre, thirteen Mi'kmaq First Nation Chiefs, Federal Minister of Indigenous Services Patty Hajdu and Nova Scotia Minister of Health and Wellness Michelle Thompson signed a trilateral Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on the next steps to help transform the design and delivery of health services for Mi'kmaq throughout the province of Nova Scotia.

This agreement has been in development since spring 2022 and defines a set of priorities and outlines the

process required to transfer the design and delivery of federal health services to the Mi'kmaq through Tajikeimik. Working on behalf of the Mi'kmaq in Nova Scotia, Tajikeimik is a Mi'kmaw health and wellness organization that is guided by the 13 Chiefs and Health Directors in the province and the Mi'kmaq Grand Council.

Through Etuaptmumk (two-eyed seeing), the program blends online study and in-person. You're introduced to the unique perspectives of the Mi'kmaq, including concepts like Msīt No'kmaq and Netukulimk.

Upon graduation, you receive your Level 2 Early Childhood Educator classification from the province of Nova Scotia.

Admission requirements

- High School Graduation Diploma or equivalent.
- · Applicants must self-identify as Aboriginal/Indigenous persons.

Study options

- This program is offered online with scheduled and non-scheduled components.
- You study online and then gather twice a year for in-person land-based learning and connection.

Work experience

- Work experiences are mandatory and provide you with the opportunity to apply your knowledge and skills outside of your classroom.
- Opportunities are typically unpaid and require a minimum of 520 hours over five scheduled work experiences.
